

Railmeets Sign-up and Registration

Please note, steps 1 & 2 are primarily for individuals that have not previously used Railmeets. If you had previously used Railmeets to register for a regatta you should be able to skip ahead to step 3.

1. **If you do not already have an account on Railmeets**, create one at <https://railmeets.com/signUp> using one of the following options...
 - a. Using your existing Google or Facebook account: More information available at <https://help.railmeets.com/article/join-railmeets-via-social>
 - b. OR using an email address and password: More information available at <https://help.railmeets.com/article/join-railmeets-via-email-and-password>
2. **If you do not have your boat setup in your account, it is recommended to do so.**
 - a. Once you have logged in to Railmeets, click "My Boats" in the menu bar



- b. Then click "Add New Boat"



- c. Provide the basic details, i.e. name, type (make/model) and sail number, about your boat and click "Submit"

4. If you are on the event page, Click on **Register as Skipper** (Be sure to read the NOR)

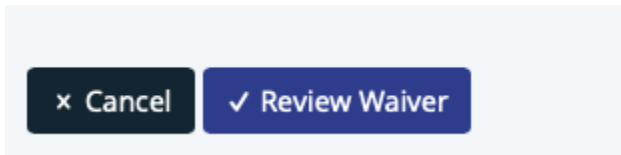

7. Click **Review Waiver** to view the waiver.



8. In the pop-up dialog check the box that you agree to the waiver. Then click **Pay and Register**.

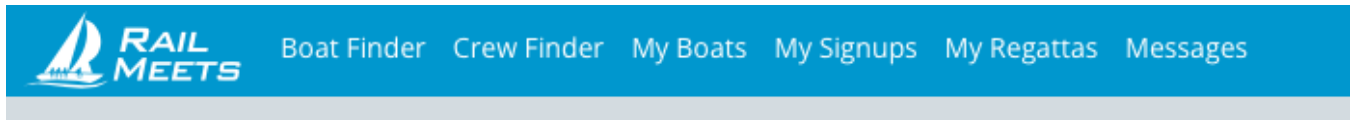

- You can click on the name of the Regatta to view the details of the regatta and go to the results page.
- You can click on the **Update** button to update your registration details.
- You can click on the **Withdraw** button to request to withdraw from the race
- The **Manage Crew** and **Copy Races** buttons are additional features in Railmeets. That work with the crew management and coordination components of Railmeets. While these features can help you manage your crew for the various regattas, for the CASRA regattas, these features are not required for you to participate in the regattas.

If you need to contact the organizers for any particular event, go to that event's page (you can click on the name of the event on your “My Regattas” page) and click the “Contact Organizers” button. This should open a draft email in your email program to the primary contacts.
